ii) Community Catalyzing and Enabling

Acting as Community Catalyst, you facilitate a space and dynamic that enables members to engage in a climate of trust that encourages collaboration and exchange. You take care of:

• Planning, coordinating and implementing *community weeklies* (regular events) with H&E coordinators (e.g. Tuesday sexy salade)

• Coordinating with program teams to reach out to interesting organizations, start-ups and individuals, inviting them to create inspiring and enabling events for members' community and public (e.g Business Help desk, Skillshare workshop, CET monthlies events, Inspiring monthlies events)

 Posting and promoting members' event via social media (Facebook, Instagram, Linkedin) and Impact Hub Geneva website

· Positioning the Hub community culture via social media (Facebook, Instagram, Linkedin)

The position is a full time (possible 80%) internship with a basic salary of 1500CHF for 6 months. Thereafter we plan this position to potentially evolve into a full-time position (CDI).
